News From Our Service Ministries:

MINISTRY OF BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS [MBG]

Red Diamond Roofing began the replacement of shingles on the church roof on Monday, June 24. They expect the work to be completed by the end of this week. We are seeking bids from contractors to replace the skylight in Fellowship Hall or perhaps remove it entirely and have it roofed to match the rest of the building. The first bid we received to replace the skylight was almost \$23,000 more than we had expected.

Work in the basement continues. All painting is done in each room with touch up painting still needed for doorways and the hallway going upstairs. Toilets have been reset and we expect the stall and sink areas to be completed this week. The carpeting is also scheduled to be installed this week. However, that will be slow process since the contractor will have to move contents from room to room to accommodate the installation. Ceiling tiles are scheduled to be replaced beginning June 29th. Before that time, we will take videos of the ceiling areas in each room and the hallway. As you can see, we are still optimistic that the basement will be done by the end of the month, but it could slip a week or so.

Zimbabwe Kidz Palisade Peach Sale

It's nearly that time of year again. The annual ZimKidz peach sale is coming soon!

Zimbabwe Kidz is a Denver Presbytery Mission Partnership made up of St. James, Green Mountain, First Littleton and St. Paul Presbyterian churches. Its mission is to drill deep wells, known in Zimbabwe as boreholes, at schools in Zimbabwe operated by local churches in the Presbytery of Zimbabwe, to provide clean drinking water to the children and the surrounding community. In the drought ravaged country, the need for clean water is very great. The largest fundraiser for this work is the annual sale of 20-pound boxes of fresh Palisade peaches.

The grower in Palisade has let us know that the peaches should be available sometime in mid-July, earlier than last year. The cost per box this year is \$40, payable at the time the boxes are picked up.
